

Further Supplementary Regulations No 1 Motorsport Australia Permit No: 224/0505/01

Supplementary Regulation Chapter 2, Item 2.5 is replaced by the following.

- **2.5** Fuel
- 2.5.1 All fuel must be in accordance with Technical Appendix Schedule G of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
- 2.5.2 Fuel can be purchased from the Race Fuels bowser, payment must be via Credit Card.
- 2.5.3 During any re-fueling of a vehicle within a pit lane garage or paddock area, Competitors must have at minimum one (1) 1kg fire extinguisher. The person conducting the refueling must, at a minimum, be attired in neck to knee coverings including a long sleeve shirt.
 - 2.5.3.1 The use of **ANY** nine (9) kg fire extinguishers provided by the circuit for use in pit lane must **NOT** be used in any refueling activity.
- 2.5.4 The maximum amount of fuel stored in any pit lane garage, paddock carport or paddock area will be sixty (60) litres.

Supplementary Regulation Chapter 2, Item 2.7.1.2 is replaced by the following.

2.7.1.2 **NO Smoking (this includes e-cigarettes and vaping) is not permitted** in any part of the Pit Lane, Pit Lane Garages, Inner Paddock and Carport area.

The two designated Smoking Zones at SMSP are;

- 1. North paddock, on the grassed area between the rear of the Carport area and the Skid Pan.
- 2. South paddock, on the left hand side grassed area directly opposite the South paddock, over the road.

The Penalty if caught smoking in any area other than the two designated Smoking Zones will be Exclusion from the Event.
