



Scrutineering



7.30 am to 9.00 am - Don't be late!

Scrutineering outside of this period is at the discretion of the clerk of the course & subject to the availability of scrutineers.

You and your car *must* pass scrutineering to be allowed on the track.

Both *must* be in TRACK READY CONDITION upon arrival at scrutineering.

For you this includes:

- **BMW Club Membership card (or other CAMS affiliated club card)**
- **CAMS licence (or Wakefield licence)**
- **Drivers Licence (road)**
- **Correct clothing (on you, not back at your garage)**
- **Helmet**
- **Medical condition (including alcohol and drug levels)**

For your car this includes:

- **Good brake pedal with operational brake lights**
- **Steering**
- **No fluid leaks**
- **Fire Extinguisher**
- **Bonnet tie-down**
- **Safe Tyres**
- **Battery triangle**
- **Taped glass (fwd facing glass aside from windshield)**
- **No loose objects**

All CAMS log booked vehicles must have their log book presented at scrutineering.

What to do next:

- **Be at the designated driver briefing point no later than 9am.**
- **Everyone must attend the briefing.**
- **Delays in briefing start time translate into reduced track time.**
