The Event will be **Multi-Club Supersprint** to be conducted at Wakefield Park Raceway on the 8th March 2020.

4. Description of the Proposed Competition

Supersprint conducted in 4 speed groups with up to 16 cars in each group, arranged fastest to slowest in each group. Group 1 is fastest thru to Group 4 is slowest.

Course is Wakefield Park, 2.2 KM Road Circuit in Clockwise direction.

Cars are mainly BMW road registered vehicles but unregistered vehicles are permitted. Running pump petrol or diesel.

15. Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances

Any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a

breach in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the Motorsport Australia website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

16. This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia MSPRA Policy.
