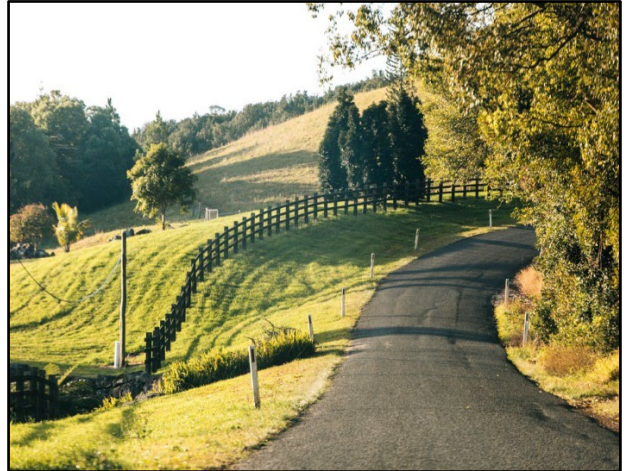

BMW Drivers Club NSW SUMMER COAST MEETS COUNTRY ESCAPE PROGRAM





Program Overview

Important information:

This program has been released early, to give members a chance to register for the event, and book in their accommodation early to avoid disappointment. It is the responsibility of each member to arrange their own accommodation, and it is recommended to book accommodation as soon as possible following successful registration for the event.

Not all activities and meals have been confirmed, so are not included in this program. Similarly, the final drive route is to be confirmed, although the program below will give attendees an idea of what route is being taken. These details will be released at a later date, and a separate event will be created and released to registered attendees, to allow them to register for activities and pay for any meals in advance.

The program table below is to provide you with an overview of the anticipated activities and drive route highlights, to help you decide if this event is for you.

Registration fee: \$60 per member. This fee is inclusive of recce run expenses, including accommodation and petrol, and secures your place for the event. Note, a refund of the registration fee will be available provided cancellation is 21days prior to the event.

Day 1 (optional)	Tuesday 27 February	Sydney members will meet and convoy to Forster stopping for lunch, fuel and comfort stops along the way. Dinner will be in Forster town.
Day 2	Wednesday 28 February	The group will have breakfast at The Artisan Farmer in Napiac, before heading to Tamworth via exciting country roads. Dinner will be at the hotel in Tamworth.
Day 3	Thursday 29 February	The group will enjoy morning activities in Tamworth, before heading to Glenn Innes, with a stop at the quaint town of Uralla. Dinner is likely to be at the motel in Glenn Innes.
Day 4	Friday 1 March	The group will depart Glenn Innes for Ballina, via the quaint town of Tenterfield, for shopping and a history lesson. Dinner location is yet to be confirmed.
Day 5	Saturday 2 March	The group will enjoy an AM drive to explore the beautiful Byron Hinterland area. Activities and lunch location are yet to be confirmed. Dinner location is yet to be confirmed.
Day 6	Sunday 3 March (optional)	The group will depart the accommodation and head south to South West Rocks for the evening (if this option is chosen). There will be comfort stops along the way at nice towns. Dinner location is yet to be confirmed.
Day 7	Monday 4 March (optional)	The remaining group members will depart South West Rocks for home.

Tuesday 27 February (Night 1 - optional)

Accommodation: Hotel Forster, 26 The Lakes Way Forster

A combination of Deluxe Queen Spa Rooms and Standard Queen Rooms have been reserved. Special group price of \$150 per night per room for the above room types.

All rooms have reverse-cycle air conditioning, free wifi, the property has a swimming pool and a half size tennis court.



Booking instructions: Contact the Hotel via phone on 6554 8100 and advise you are with the BMW Drivers Club NSW and provide the date of the stay to receive the special rate. The rooms and special rate can only be held until 7 January, please book by this date.

Breakfast – We will be having breakfast in Nabiac at The Artisan Farmer on the Pacific Highway. The Hotel also offers an in room breakfast if you prefer, simply complete the breakfast form in your room and provide it to reception by 6pm.



Wednesday 28 February (Night 2)

Accommodation: Powerhouse Hotel Tamworth by Rydges, 248 Armidale Road Tamworth

A number of Powerhouse King Rooms have been reserved for our group at a discounted rate of \$240 per night per room. Each room include bespoke interiors, custom pillow top king beds, marble bathroom, air conditioning, free wifi, coffee pod machine, Foxtel and a 60" 4K smart TV. The property also has a restaurant and separate bar onsite, and an excellent swimming pool.



Breakfast - Breakfast at the hotel the following morning is optional at \$20 per person. It is however highly recommended as it is delicious! Breakfast commences at 6:30am in the Workshop Kitchen (the Hotel's restaurant). Simply head down and have breakfast at your leisure, but ensure you allow enough time to meet the group at the designated time for departure.

Booking instructions: Simply register and pay for the event through the BMW Drivers Club event page, and Ash will provide your name to the Powerhouse Hotel staff at Rydges and they will secure your room. Payment can be made at the time of check in.



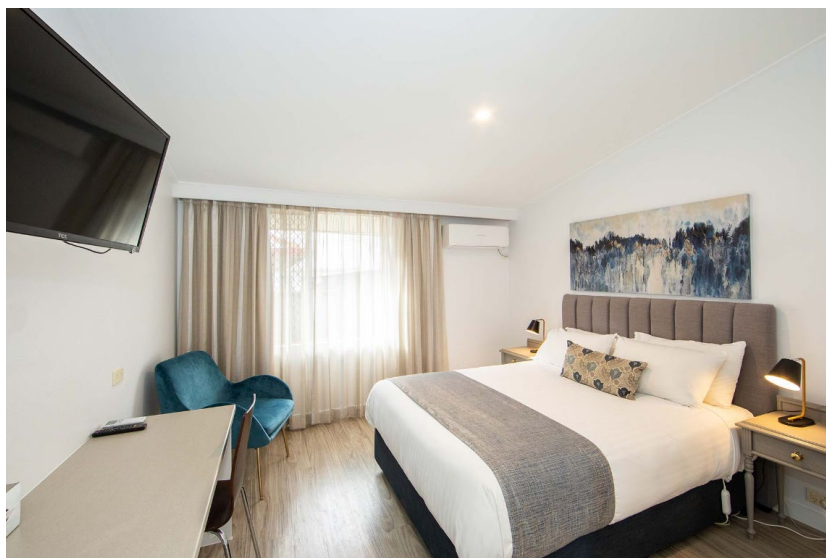
Thursday 29 February (Night 3)

Accommodation: New England Motor Lodge, 160 Church Street Glenn Innes

A number of Queen Rooms have been reserved for the group. If you wish to secure a larger room with a kitchenette or a King Bed, simply ask reception. The property is 4 star, and all rooms are on the ground floor and off the main highway, all rooms have air conditioning, free wifi, and have been recently renovated. The property has an outdoor lagoon swimming pool. Car parking is available directly outside the rooms.

The Queen Room rate for the night is \$170 per night for 1-2 guests.



Breakfast: Breakfast at the motel is \$25 per person and is available in the on-site restaurant from 7-9am. If you choose this option please ensure you are finished by the convoy departure time.

Note, please advise the motel at the time of check-in that you wish to have breakfast. There are several options for breakfast in Town including a bakery if you'd like to do something more casual.



Friday 1 March & Saturday 2 March (Nights 4 & 5)

Accommodation: Ramada Hotel & Suites by Wyndham Ballina Byron, 2 Martin Street Ballina

The Ramada has a number of room types available for you to choose from, simply head to the Ramada website above to determine what room you prefer.

Important: To receive the group booking discount, you MUST phone reception on 6618 1000, and quote the group booking code: 475327 to receive the reservation discount. You cannot use the code and book online.

The Ramada offers a huge outdoor heated pool, fitness centre, two onsite restaurants and is located on the river. The hotel also offers styling and beauty services, and has an onsite wine shop and tasting room called "ISOLA". The hotel is only a few minutes walk from the main street of town. There is also underground parking. The Ramada has no single or twin bed options.



Breakfast: As at November 2023, the breakfast restaurant on site is being renovated. There are plenty of local options for breakfast, or alternatively the restaurant may be open by Feb 2024. More information to follow.



Sunday 3 March (Night 5 – Optional)

Accommodation: Rockpool Motor Inn, 45 McIntyre Street, South West Rocks

A number of rooms have been reserved for the group, with two different room types to select from. 8 x Studio Twin Room - \$178. 4 x King Spa Room - \$209. These rates are for 2 people, additional people are \$20 per person.

The motor inn is a 10minute walk to the beach and the village centre and offers undercover parking and a heated pool with a restaurant on site.



Booking instructions: Call the motor inn on 6566 7755 and advise you are with the BMW Drivers Club NSW and confirm the room type you wish to book.
